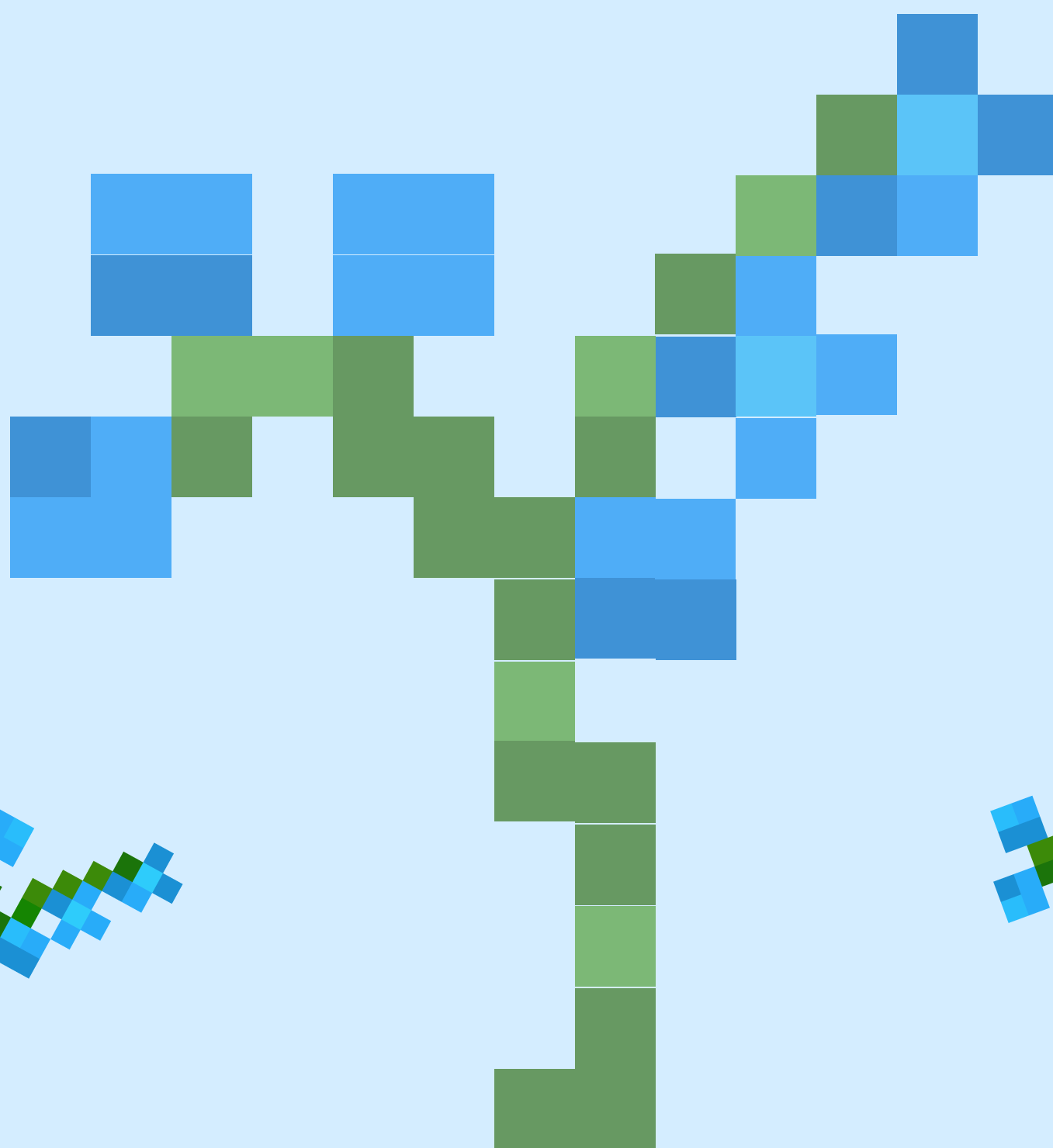

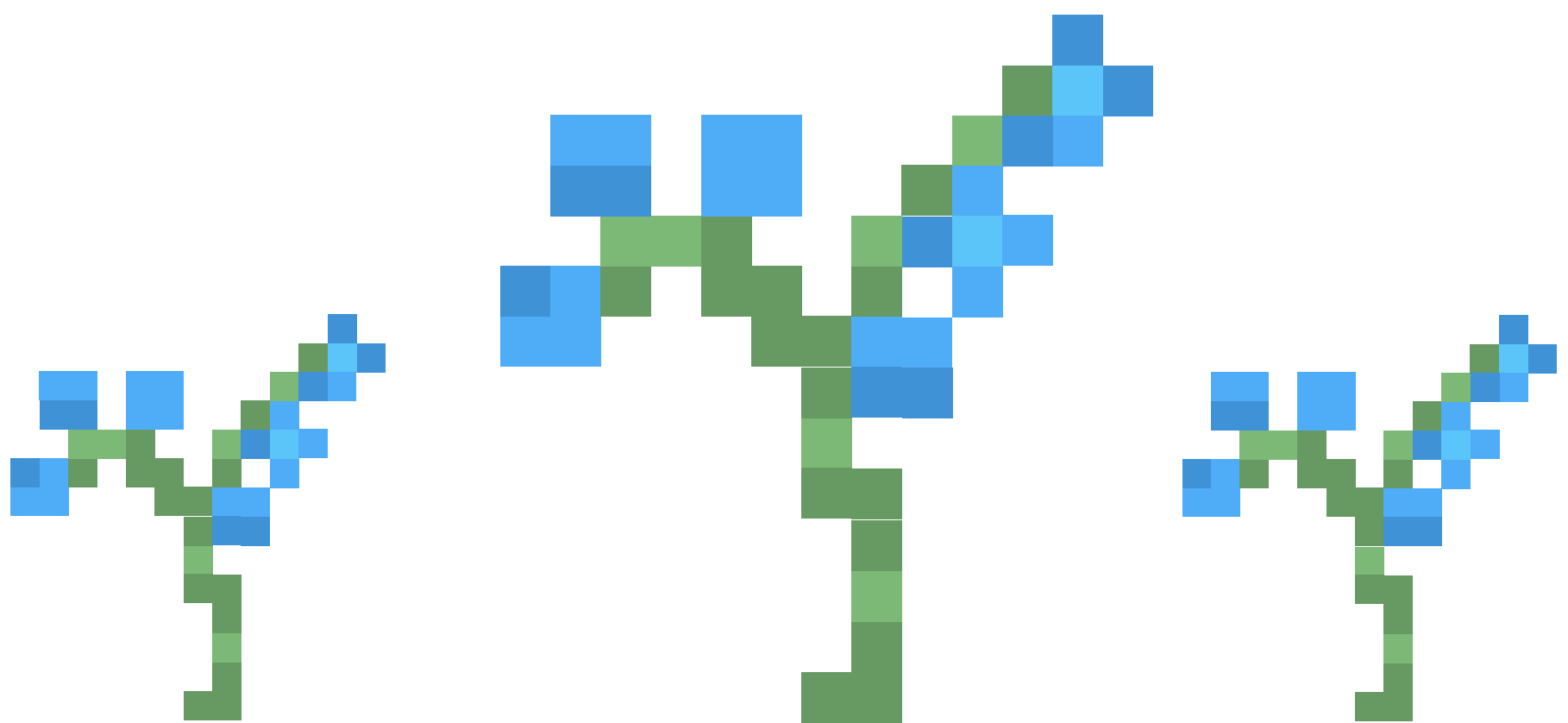

# You need:

Wooden Cubes, 20mm/ 2cm  
(I get mine from Amazon)  
You can also get Wooden  
Cubes in the size 10mm/ 1cm  
if you want a smaller flower.

Glue (I use "All-purpose glue"  
but you can probably also use  
Gorilla glue or wood glue)

Acrylic Paint

(a brand doesn't really matter as long as it has good coverage and is maybe not as watery (cause of the wood you know?))

(blue, green, white and black)

# Color Palette:

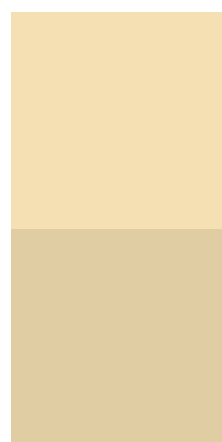


Total:  
68 Cubes



(cubes for visualization)

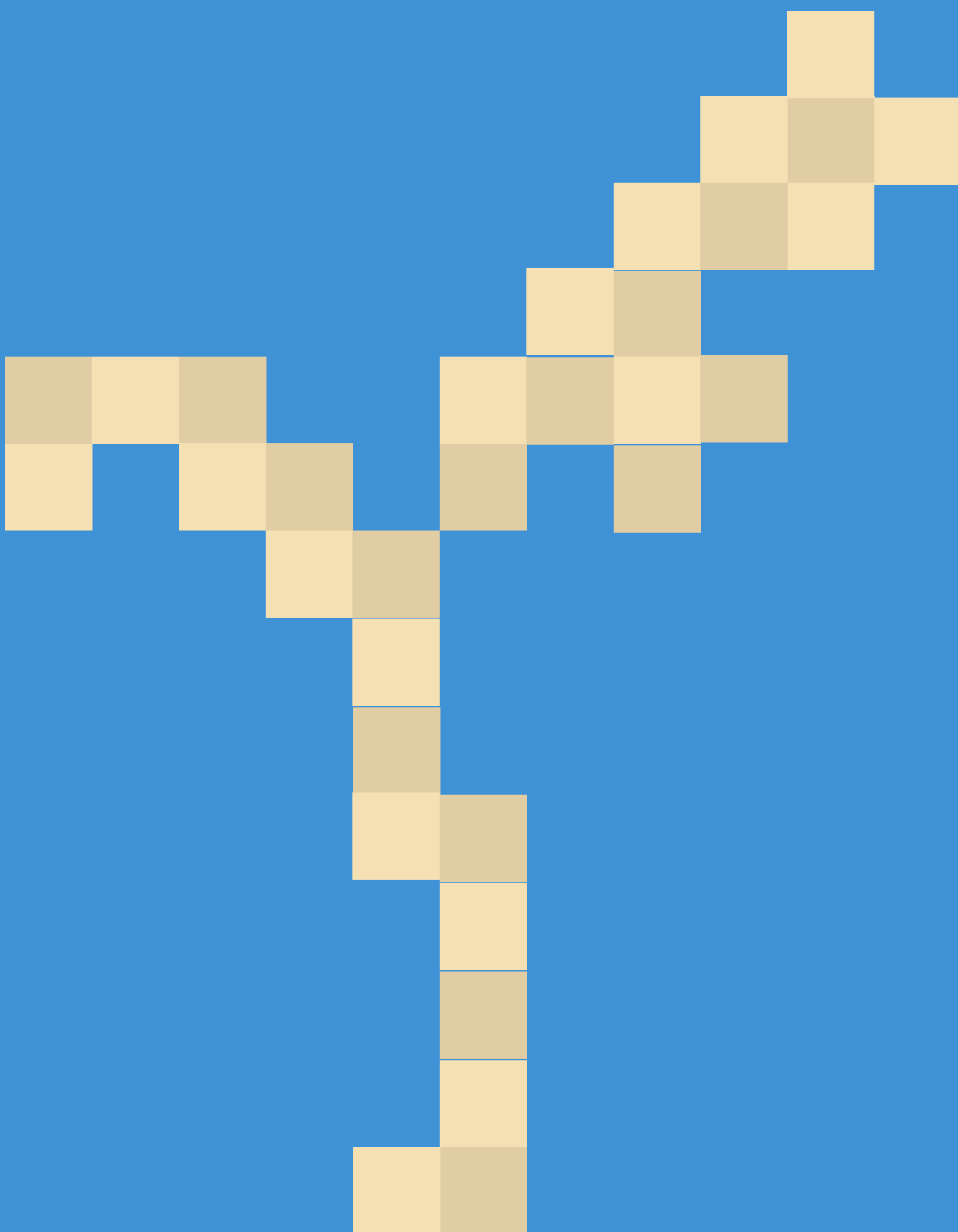
I always glue two  
cubes together and  
let it dry



afterwards I glue the  
pairs together

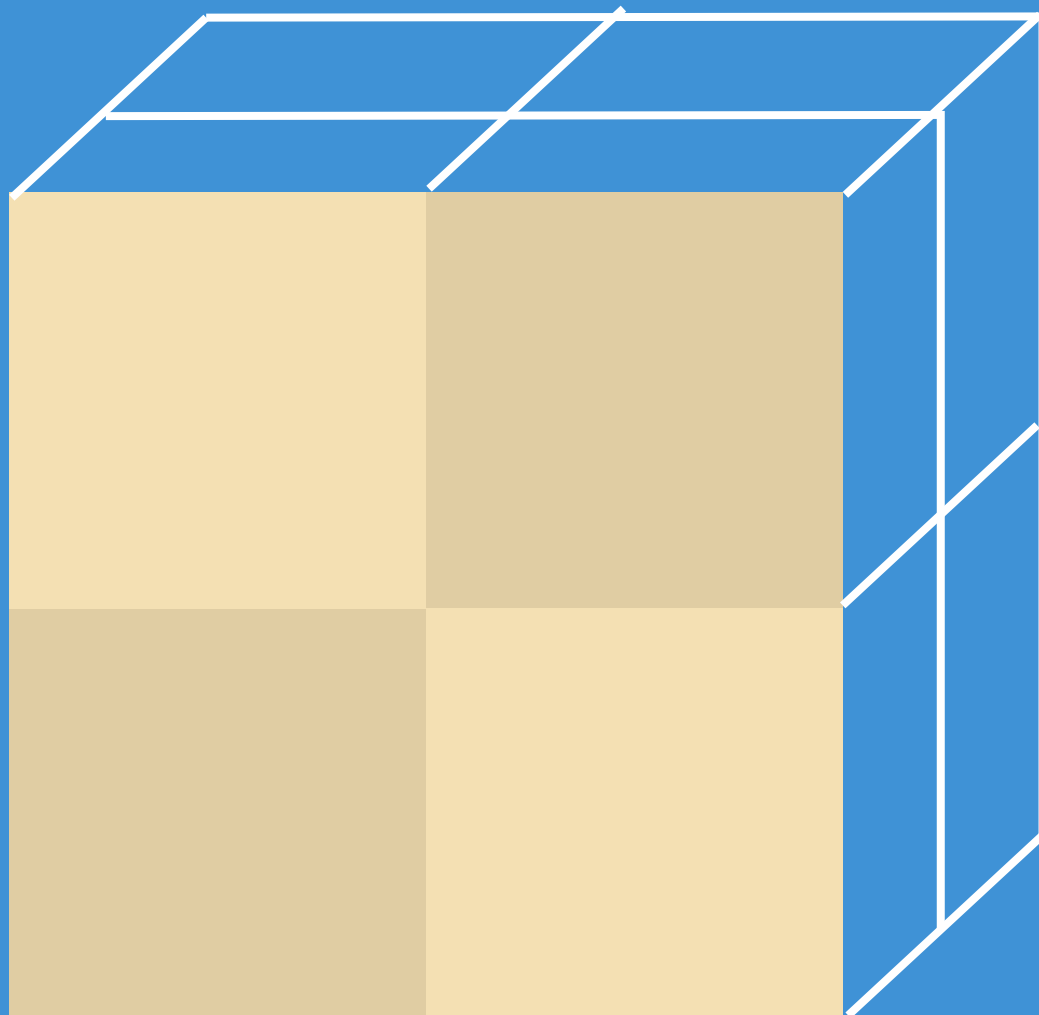
# Shape:

glue your cubes into this 2D shape.



3D:

glue these pieces again which you  
can add to your flower base.



4x





Both Sides

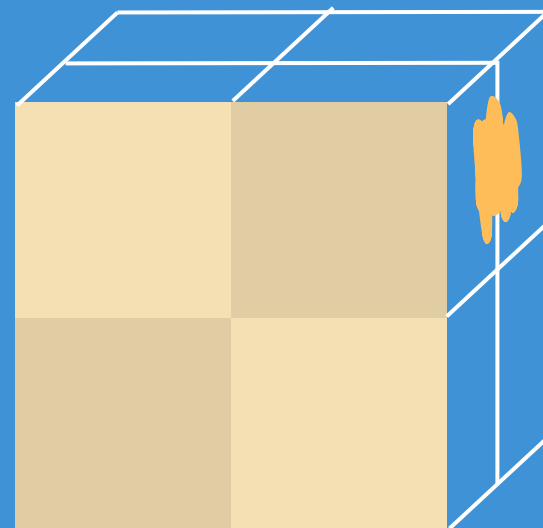
(glue both sides  
the same)

glue the   
onto the 



single cube

glue the   
onto the 



(don't glue on a cube, glue in  
between two cubes so it is more  
symmetrical overall)

# Paint:

Start painting :))

(you can start with any color you want, I would recommend that you finish one color before you switch to the next one)

I basically mixed three different shades of blue and two different shades of green

If you struggle while painting, don't forget:

Tape exists
